**ELIGIBILITY:** Ages 5-Adult (Must be age by August 1<sup>ST</sup> 2009)

**REGISTRATION FEE:** INDIVIDUAL 5 Yrs. old \$50 (\$70 w/Fundraiser Buyout Fee)

INDIVIDUAL 6-18 Yrs. \$70.00 (\$90 w/ Fundraiser Buyout Fee)

2-PLAYERS \$140.00 "SAME FAMILY and/or household"(\$180.W/FUND.FEE)

Maximum Family/Household Fee \$200.00 (\$240. W/FUNDRAISER FEE)

### **ADDITIONAL COSTS:**

**LATE FEES:** Any registration received after July 5th will be assessed a \$10.00 /late fee.

**REFUNDS:** Players who drop **before August 1st** will receive refund minus \$10.00 service fee. **No refunds after 8/1 for any reason.**

**FUNDRAISERS:** As noted in above fee information, each family is required to support the program by selling Fundraising Products (forms available through your coach, it is your responsibility to ask for it). However you do have the option to pay an additional \$20.00 PER PLAYER (\$40.00 FAM. FEE) **at the time of registration** in lieu of selling products.

**NOTE: HEAD COACH'S AND REFEREE'S CHILDREN AND TRAVEL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN FUNDRAISERS.**

**Uniform Policy:** SHIN GUARDS, FEDERATION RULES MAKE SHIN GUARDS MANDATORY. PLAYERS MUST BE PREPARED WITH SHIN GUARDS AT PRACTICES AND GAMES. This year we will be requiring **all players 10 years old and up** to purchase their own black soccer shorts with an inseam of at least 4". Used and new shorts will be available for purchase at the concession stand.. Per FIFA, **no** wire framed glasses may be worn.
